




TSU NSBE OFFICERS 2025 - 2026

DEVELOPMENT EVENTS

GENERAL BODY MEETINGS - \$200

General Body Meetings (GBM) is an opportunity to foster camaraderie and growth among members & officers within our chapter.

- ◆ Opportunity for companies to host and present at general body meetings while interacting with the membership.
- ◆ Occurrence: 4x per semester starting in September



STUDY NIGHTS/ACADEMIC BOWLS - \$150

Study Nights/ Academic Bowls are events with the purpose to increase the chapter-wide GPA as well as influence significant academic growth across all majors.

- ◆ Opportunity for companies to sponsor an event that enhances the scholastic capabilities of our members
- ◆ Occurrence: 2-3 events per semester

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS - \$150

Professional Development Workshops provide members with valuable skills, career insights, and networking opportunities to enhance their professional growth.

- ◆ Opportunity for companies to host and lead workshops focused on career readiness, technical skills, and industry insights.
- ◆ Engaging sessions designed to prepare members for internships, job opportunities, and leadership roles.
- ◆ Occurrence: 4x per semester starting in September.





TSU CHAPTER DEVELOPMENT EVENTS

INDUSTRY TOURS AND SITE VISITS - \$500

Industry Tours & Site Visits provide NSBE TSU members with real-world exposure to engineering environments through guided visits to firms, construction sites, labs, and public works facilities.



- ◆ Opportunity for companies to host students, highlight their work culture, and engage directly with future engineers.
- ◆ These tours help students understand various engineering career paths while building professional connections and networking confidence.
- ◆ Funds primarily support transportation costs, making it possible for all interested students to attend, regardless of access to personal vehicles.
- ◆ Occurrence: 2–3 visits per semester starting in September.



ORGANIZATION DRIVES - \$150

Organization Drives are high-visibility campus outreach efforts designed to promote NSBE TSU, boost membership, and raise awareness of upcoming chapter events and initiatives.



- ◆ Opportunity for companies to support recruitment-focused tabling events that enhance our chapter's presence and student engagement.
- ◆ Drives feature flyer distribution, promotional items, and branded table displays strategically set up during high-traffic periods such as Weeks of Welcome or National NSBE Week.
- ◆ Funds support food and light refreshments to attract passersby and encourage interaction, as well as NSBE merchandise advertising (shirts, buttons, stickers) to showcase our brand and identity.
- ◆ Occurrence: 1x per semester.

OUTREACH EVENTS

PRE-COLLEGE INITIATIVE (PCI) - \$1000

The Pre-College Initiative is an opportunity to increase the presence of minority children in the engineering pipeline and to help reach the national NSBE goal of graduating 10,000 African American engineers annually by the year 2025.

- ◆ By partnering with our chapter, your funds assist us in organizing events centered around increasing interest in STEM for underprivileged youth in the Houston area.
- ◆ Sample Events Include STEM-related activities for Grades 3-12, Mock career fairs/mentorship, High school visits/Discussion panels, Bridge competition, Company Visits

- ◆ Occurrence: 2-4 per semester



TECHNICAL OUTREACH AND COMMUNITY HELP (T.O.R.C.H) - \$1000

The Technical Outreach and Community Help program is an opportunity for our organization to create a stronger link between NSBE and Houston's minority community.

- ◆ Funds allocated to T.O.R.C.H programming will be used to purchase supplies to serve our community. Sample Events Include: A Walk for Education, Community Service, Garden Volunteering.
- ◆ Days of Service (MLK, Thanksgiving, Earth Day, etc.)
- ◆ Occurrence: 2-4 events per semester.
